


## **2023 FY Accomplishments**

At 12 years old, I had experienced a lifetime of pain and suffering. I was in and out of foster homes, two residential placements and three acute psychiatric hospitalizations. I developed a number of serious behavioral problems, which JFBHS specialized in. Eventually I had a breakthrough with his behaviors and academic achievement. I noticed my anger management and physical aggression was improving. I am incredibly grateful for the services I received at Jackson-Feild and a promising future ahead of me.

My husband and I were frantic and desperate to help our son Chris. We loved him dearly and nothing we tried seemed to be effective. We were relived that JFBHS would help our son. The staff taught him how to take responsibility for his actions and how to work through his problems to become a better person. Chris underwent a drastic transformation and he became the young man that we all knew he could be. There are so many children struggling with mental illness or substance abuse, and in these situations, it is often forgotten that the child's family and loved ones are also deeply affected. We are so happy that Jackson-Feild was there to help Chris, and we will be eternally grateful. —Chris's Mom
