

When Linda's son, Zion arrived at Jackson-Feild, his life was spiraling. He had been expelled from school twice, was skipping classes, drinking, and making choices that landed him in court. With his grades failing and the future uncertain, a judge allowed him to come to Jackson-Feild in lieu of jail time — a decision that changed everything.

"Almost immediately," says Linda, "Zion's father and I noticed a difference. The structure and boundaries at Jackson-Feild helped Zion settle in and begin responding positively to expectations and consistent support." Not only did Zion succeed with his treatment, "I earned my high school diploma!" he says with well-deserved pride.

It's been more than ten years since I lived at Jackson-Feild," says Zion. "Today, I have a full-time job that I enjoy, I'm engaged to be married, and I coach my soon to-be stepdaughter's softball team. It's a good life, and I have Jackson-Feild to thank for helping me put my life back on track."

Zion is not the only one who credits and thanks Jackson-Feild. "Zion has grown into the young man I always knew he could be," says his mother with a glow of absolute love for her son and pride in all he's accomplished.

Zion has a few closing remarks he wants to share:

"To the judge who gave me the choice of Jackson-Feild or juvie, thank you! At the time, neither choice seemed great to the angry teen that I was, but you put me on a path that changed my life.

"To donors and supporters, please keep giving your gifts! They really do help children. I know they do, because I was one of them. To the staff at Jackson-Feild, please keep doing what you're doing. It works."


Linda was so impressed by the impact that JFBHS provided her son and now serves on our board of trustees.





FINANCIAL STATEMENT FOR FY 2025


